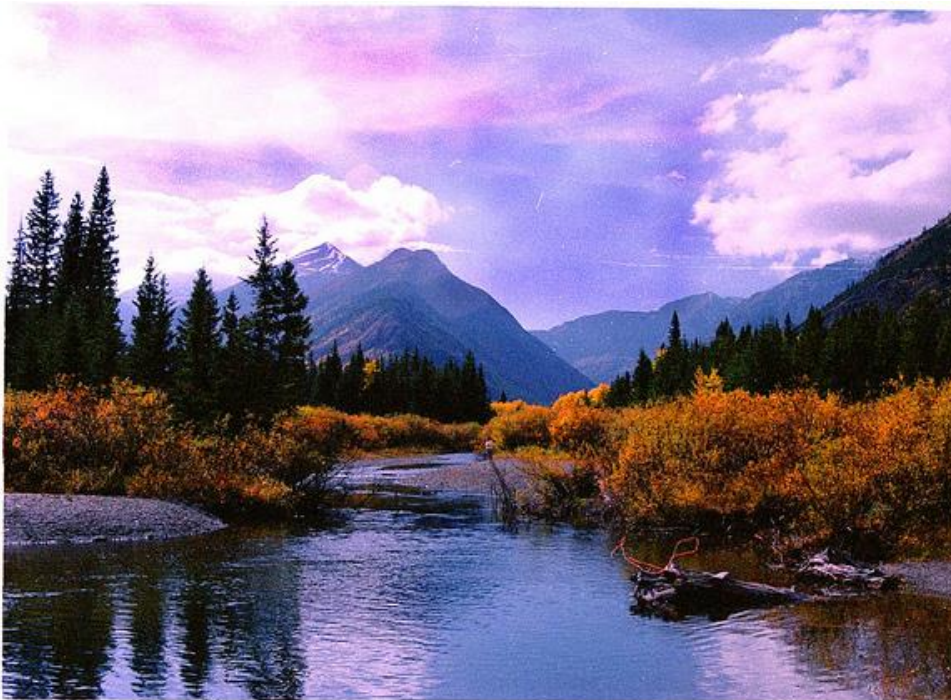




OWC and the Castle – Input based on Consensus
