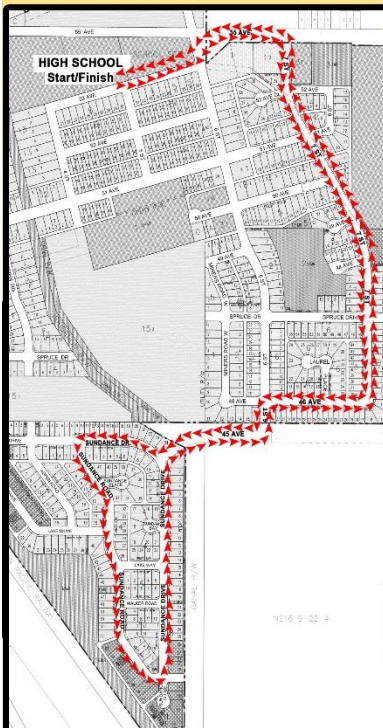

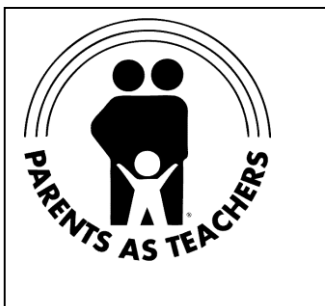

Heavy Rainfall Events

With heavy rainfall storms being more frequent in Southern Alberta residents need to take action to protect their properties, neighboring properties, and municipal infrastructure.

During a rain storm, it is very important to be sure to have adequate downspout extensions attached to your home. This will protect your foundation from possible damage. It may also protect your basement from flooding, and help protect the town's sewer system from being overloaded.

It is against the Town of Coalhurst Utility By-Law to have sump pumps discharge to the sanitary sewer system in your house or discharge to floor drains. The Town of Coalhurst will be conducting inspections on properties to enforce this By-law. If you are unsure about this by-law and how it affects your property, you can contact the town office for a voluntary inspection and advice on rectifying this concern. If your house is in an area of town that has a separate storm piping system, sump pumps may discharge to this system, and if not they must discharge to surface and be directed to flow storm water away from your foundation to the street or lane.

Since July of 2013, the Town of Coalhurst does not treat wastewater, all sanitary sewer is pumped to the City of Lethbridge for treatment. The costs of pumping and treating the sanitary sewer can be reduced if everyone does their part to reduce the infiltration of storm water to the sanitary sewer system. Please install downspout extensions long enough for water to flow away from your foundation. Talk to your friends and neighbors and spread the word. Help protect property and reduce sewer costs.

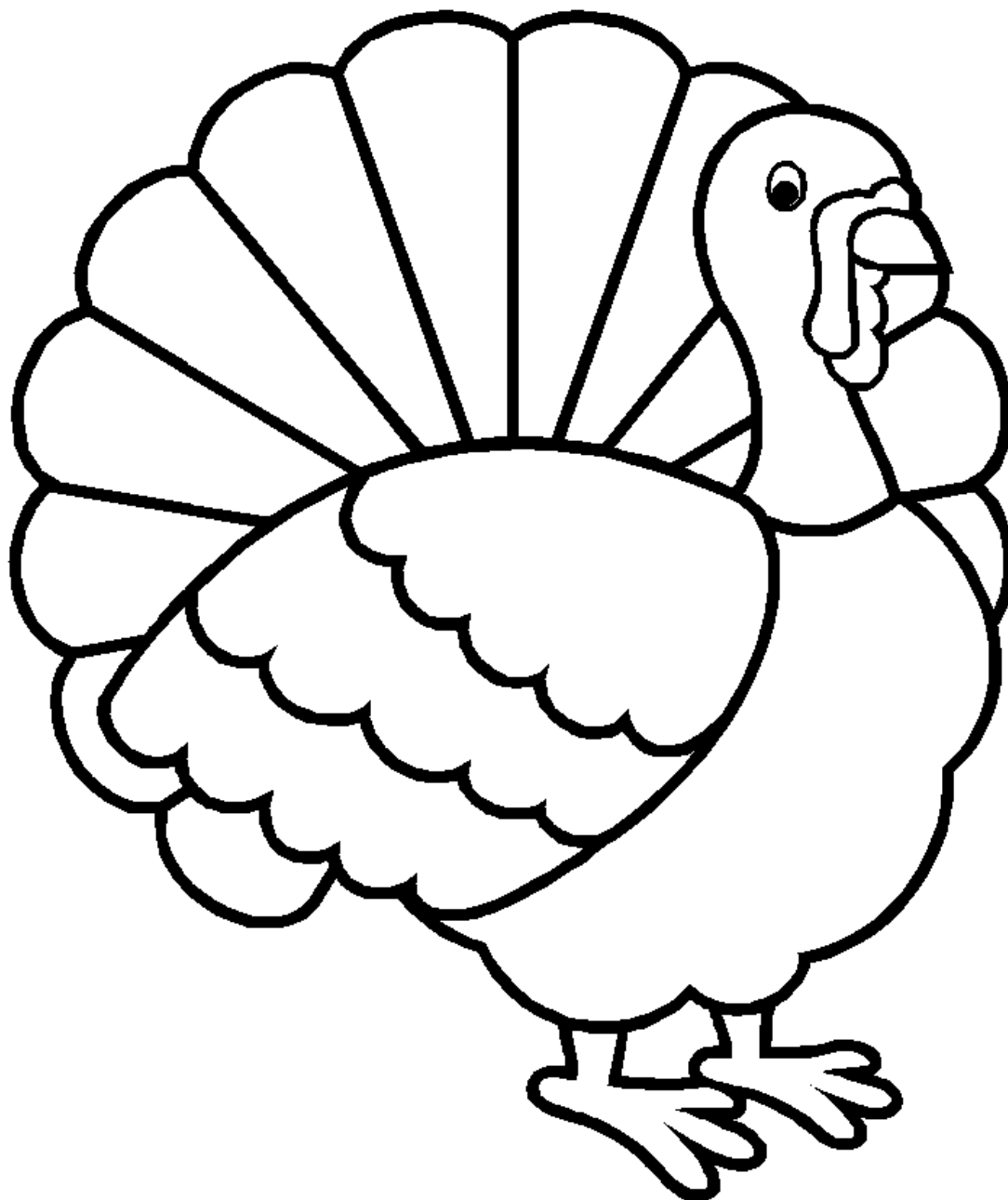
