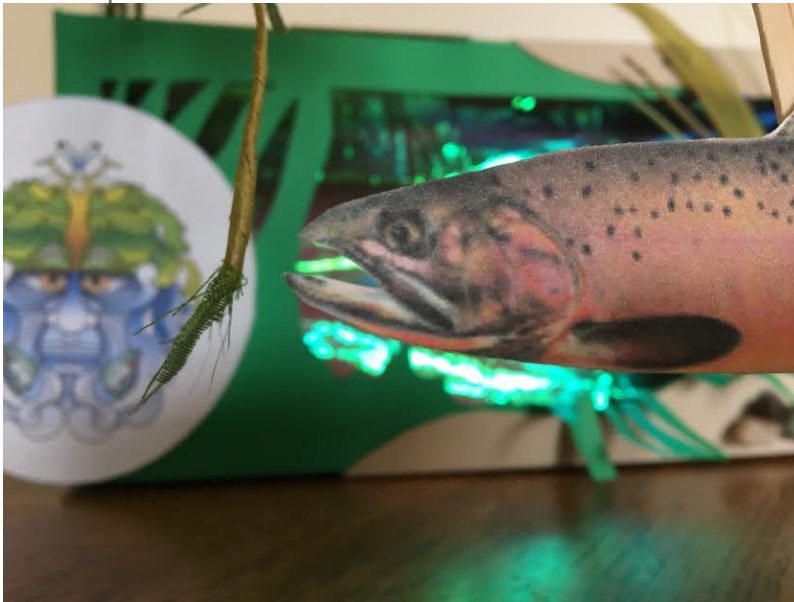


Fish Sticks!
