2:00-4:00 Using Visual Supports

This workshop will provide participants with practical information relaying how visuals can be incorporated as a learning tool with all individuals and across environments (IE. school, workplace, community, home).

12:00-2:00 - Anxiety - Understanding the Roots of Anxiety and Practical Strategies to Help

Participants will be provided with an overview of anxiety (causes, symptoms, and functions). They will also be provided with concrete strategies they can start to integrate into their practice to help support individuals in utilizing anxiety inmore adapative manners both in and out of the school setting.

2:00-4:00 Autism

Autism Spectrum Disorder can cause significant challenges for individuals and families in their daily lives. This worshop will provide participants with a basic understanding of the features of this disorder, simple strategies to positively support individuals and families with behavioural, communication, regulation, self-help, and socialization challenges.
