TOWN OF COALHURST
UTILITY AND PROPERTY TAX DEFERRAL PROGRAM



The Town of Coalhurst is now introducing a 90-day Utility and Property Tax Deferral Program. This will give Coalhurst residents the option to defer Town utility and tax payments for up to 90 days when faced with financial hardships related to COVID-19.

These measures are in alignment with the Financial Support announcement made by the Alberta Government on March 18, 2020.

The 90-day deferral program **does not cancel** these payments, but it will provide temporary financial relief for those who need it. Overdue penalties and water shut-offs will be suspended for 90-days (April, May, and June). After that time, residents will be expected to enter into payment agreements with the Town in order to pay their bills off in a timely fashion.

If you are able to however, it is recommended that you make regular payments as normal. Anyone requiring deferral of payments are asked to contact the Town to make those arrangements.

Also, if you are on Tax or Utility Autopay, and would like to be removed temporarily, please contact the Town with your name and Tax Roll number, Utility Account number or physical property address. **It will be your responsibility to notify the Town when you would like to enroll again.**

We hope that this will give residents some peace of mind during these difficult and unknown times.
