PUBLIC NOTICE
PLAYGROUNDS TO REOPEN

All Town of Coalhurst play structures, park benches and picnic tables will reopen to the public on May 29, 2020.

Park users must still comply with the COVID-19 public health orders in place including gathering restrictions and maintain physical distancing of 2 metres between individuals not from the same household. Those who are sick or have symptoms related to COVID-19 must not use any public amenities.

Other precautions and actions to consider when using playgrounds and other amenities:

- Practice proper hand hygiene.
 - Wash/sanitize your hands often
 - Refrain from touching your face
 - Carry and use hand sanitizer containing at least 60 per cent alcohol content immediately before and after touching playground equipment or other parks amenities.
- Consider limiting children and other members of your household to only visiting playgrounds that are close to your home. This will help limit the number of people your family may come into contact with.
- If a playground is frequently used, consider the additional risk this may pose to your family and avoid this spot.
- Maintain physical distancing and limit congregating with other people when entering and leaving the playground and supervising children playing (e.g. paths, benches, walkways).
- Individuals should maintain physical distancing when returning to vehicles or homes.
- Play structures will not be cleaned and residents will be using playgrounds at their own risk.

The campground, washrooms and social area in Miners Memorial Park will remain closed at this time. However, the RV sewer dump is open.
