A. That an Election will be held for the filling of the following offices:

B. That an election will be held for the election of a Senate nominee for the purposes of the *Alberta Senate Election Act*;

C. That a vote of the electors will be held on the following referendum question(s) under the *Referendum Act*:

Should section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982 – Parliament and the government of Canada’s commitment to the principle of making equalization payments – be removed from the constitution?

Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?

Voting will take place on the 18th day of October 2021, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Voting stations will be located at:

An **ADVANCE VOTE** will take place on the 14th day of October, 2021 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Town of Coalhurst Administration Office, 100 - 51 Avenue, Coalhurst, Alberta.

INCAPACITATED VOTERS can make arrangements to have the Returning Officer bring a ballot box to their home on the 14th day of October, 2021 between the hours of 2:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. by calling the Town Office at 403-381-3033 no later than 4:30 p.m. on the 13th day of October, 2021.

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one or more of Government – issued identification showing the name, address and a photo of the elector such as:

- i. Operator/driver’s licence
- ii. Government photo identification card

Chief Electoral Officer – approved identification showing the name and address of the elector such as:

- i. Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque
- ii. Government cheque or cheque stub
- iii. Income/property tax assessment notice
- iv. Utility bill, e.g. telephone, gas, water

as required by section 53 of the Local Authorities Election Act.
