The next municipal election will be October 18, 2021. In accordance with new legislation, Nomination Papers can be submitted to the Town Office during regular office hours anytime from January 1, 2021 to September 20, 2021. Nomination papers will not be accepted after 12:00 p.m. on September 20.

A candidate may withdraw his or her nomination at any time during the nomination period and up to 24 hours after the close of nominations (until 12:00 p.m. September 21, 2021).

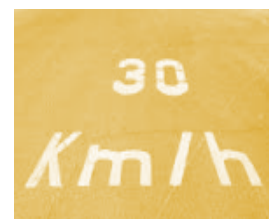

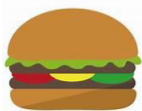

PURSUANT to sections 230, 606, and 692 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of the Town of Coalhurst in the Province of Alberta hereby gives notice of its intention to consider Bylaw No. 427-21, being an amendment to the Municipal Development Plan for the municipality.

THE PURPOSE of the proposed Bylaw No. 427-21 is to clarify the Future Land Use Concept which identifies the overall growth management strategy for the Town of Coalhurst by replacing the existing map and updating corresponding policy to align with updated map;

### EMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (EI) PROGRAM

We made temporary changes to the Employment Insurance (EI) program to better support Canadians who need financial assistance. As of September 27, 2020, the minimum benefit rate for EI regular claimants is \$500 per week before taxes in most cases.

### CANADA RECOVERY BENEFIT (CRB)

The Canada Recovery Benefit provides support to eligible workers who:

- are not employed or self-employed for reasons related to COVID-19 or have had their income reduced by at least 50% due to COVID-19;
- are not eligible for Employment Insurance (EI).

If you apply on or after July 18, 2021 or if you received this benefit for 42 weeks, you can receive \$300 (\$270 after taxes withheld) per week. If you applied before July 18, 2021, you can receive \$500 (\$450 after taxes withheld) for 42 weeks. This benefit is available for 54 weeks until October 23, 2021.

### CANADA RECOVERY SICKNESS BENEFIT (CRSB)

The CRSB provides \$500 (\$450 after taxes withheld) per week for up to a maximum of four weeks, for workers who:

- Are unable to work for at least 50% of the week because they contracted COVID-19;
- Are self-isolated for reasons related to COVID-19;
- Have underlying conditions, are undergoing treatments or have contracted other sicknesses that, in the opinion of a medical practitioner, nurse practitioner, person in authority, government or public health authority, would make them more susceptible to COVID-19.

### CANADA RECOVERY CAREGIVING BENEFIT (CRCB)

The CRCB provides \$500 (\$450 after taxes withheld) for up to 42 weeks per household for workers:

- unable to work for at least 50% of the week because they must care for a child under the age of 12 or family member because schools, day-cares or care facilities are closed due to COVID-19;
- because the child or family member is sick and/or required to quarantine or is at high risk of serious health implications because of COVID-19.
