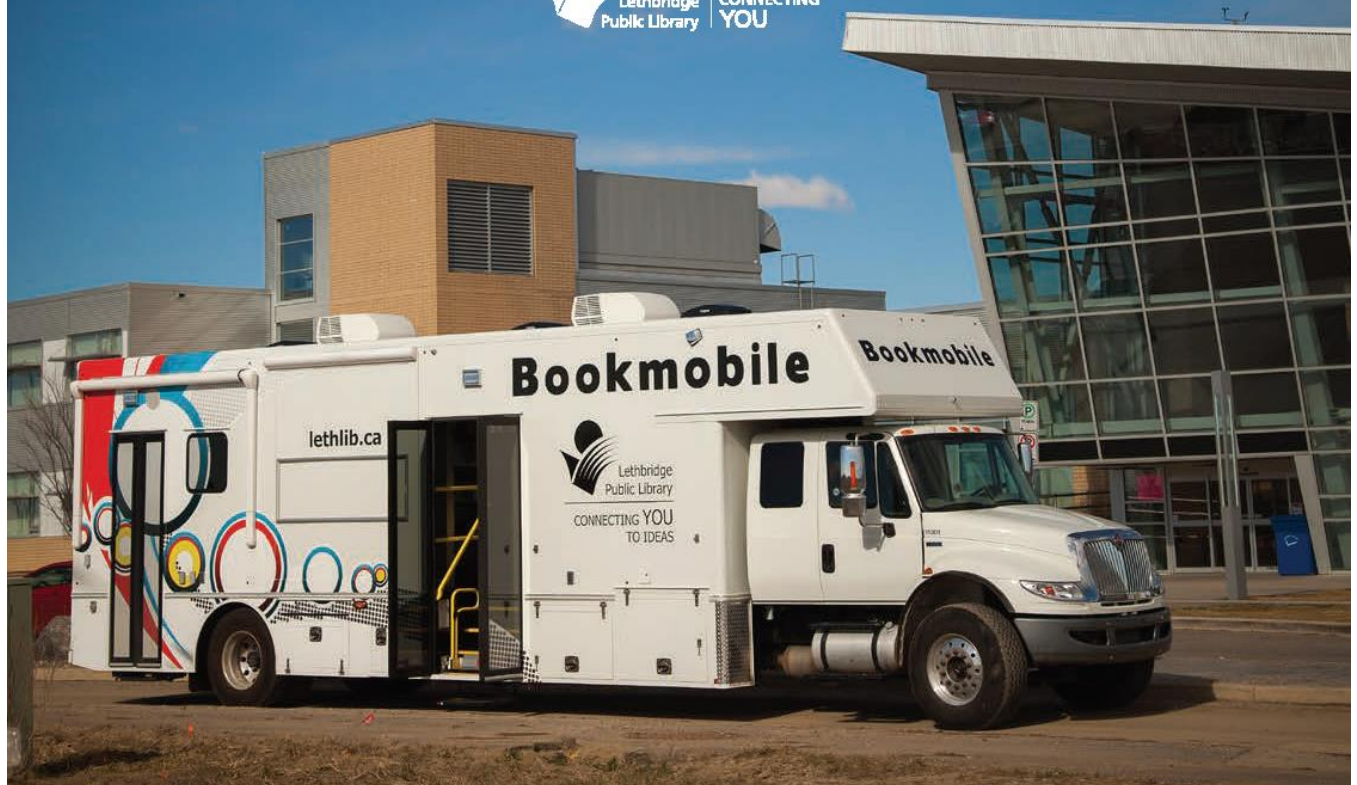

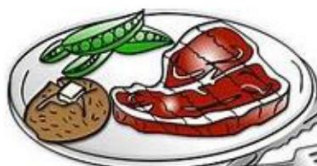

### EMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (EI) PROGRAM

We made temporary changes to the Employment Insurance (EI) program to better support Canadians who need financial assistance. For claims starting between September 26, 2021 and November 20, 2021, the minimum benefit rate for EI clients is \$300 per week before taxes in most cases.

### CANADA RECOVERY BENEFIT (CRB)

The Canada Recovery Benefit provides support to eligible workers who:

- are not employed or self-employed for reasons related to COVID-19 or have had their income reduced by at least 50% due to COVID-19;
- are not eligible for Employment Insurance (EI).

If you apply on or after July 18, 2021 or if you received this benefit for 42 weeks, you can receive \$300 (\$270 after taxes withheld) per week. If you applied before July 18, 2021, you can receive \$500 (\$450 after taxes withheld) for 42 weeks. This benefit is available for 54 weeks until October 23, 2021.

### CANADA RECOVERY SICKNESS BENEFIT (CRSB)

The CRSB provides \$500 (\$450 after taxes withheld) per week for up to a maximum of four weeks, for workers who:

- Are unable to work for at least 50% of the week because they contracted COVID-19;
- Are self-isolated for reasons related to COVID-19;
- Have underlying conditions, are undergoing treatments or have contracted other sicknesses that, in the opinion of a medical practitioner, nurse practitioner, person in authority, government or public health authority, would make them more susceptible to COVID-19.

### CANADA RECOVERY CAREGIVING BENEFIT (CRCB)

The CRCB provides \$500 (\$450 after taxes withheld) for up to 42 weeks per household for workers:

- unable to work for at least 50% of the week because they must care for a child under the age of 12 or family member because schools, day-cares or care facilities are closed due to COVID-19;
- because the child or family member is sick and/or required to quarantine or is at high risk of serious health implications because of COVID-19.

### CANADA EMERGENCY WAGE SUBSIDY (CEWS)

As a Canadian employer who continues to be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, you may be eligible to apply for one of the two subsidies to cover part of your employee wages.

### CANADA RECOVERY HIRING PROGRAM (CRHP)

The CRHP and the Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) support wages you pay through different phases of your economic recovery. Each claim period, eligible employers can claim either CRHP or CEWS, whichever is higher.

**The Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy is available until October 23, 2021.**

**The Canada Recovery Hiring Program is available retroactively to June 6, 2021 and until November 20, 2021.**

We have extended the maximum duration of the Work-Sharing program from 38 weeks to 76 weeks for employers affected by COVID-19. ## PEACE OFFICER MESSAGE NOVEMBER 2021

As we move into the winter months and temperatures start to drop, I would like to remind Coalhurst residents of the following to keep our neighborhoods safe:

- Camping season has come to an end and all holiday trailers, motorhomes and tent trailers need to be removed from the roadway and properly stored.
- All property owners are responsible for the removal of snow, ice and other obstructions from the sidewalks adjoining their property within 48 hours of it being deposited.
- New Town Walking Path - Dogs need to be on a leash as there are no off-leash areas in the Town of Coalhurst. This includes the new Town walking path. Also, please ensure you are cleaning up after your dog(s) as there are doggie bag stations located around town for your convenience.
- Invoices for dog license renewals will be sent out the beginning of the 2022 year and must be renewed by January 31, 2022. If there is a change in the status of your owned dog(s), please let me know so we may update our files.
- Trees on private property are the responsibility of the property owner. Privately owned trees which overhang public land are the sole responsibility of the property owner to maintain. Fall is a great time to trim trees before the snow falls.

## FALL LEAF AND BRANCH COLLECTION



The Town of Coalhurst will be offering a leaf, yard waste and branch collection for the fall of 2021 on **October 18<sup>th</sup>** and **November 15<sup>th</sup>**.

Leaves and compostable yard waste such as plants and flowers must be in **disposable brown paper bags** available at the Town of Coalhurst office (Maximum 5 per household) or for purchase at various retailers. If leaves are in any other type of bag or container, they will not be picked up.

Branches must be cut to a maximum length of 6 ft. Please tie smaller branches in manageable bundles with string or twine.

Bags and branches can be placed neatly along the fence in your rear lane. If you do not have a rear lane, they can be placed at the front of your property **no earlier than 1 week before** the collection date. Please do not block rear lanes or sidewalks. The bags and branches must be out **by 7:30 am on October 18<sup>th</sup> & November 15<sup>th</sup>** and there will be **no callbacks** for pick-up.

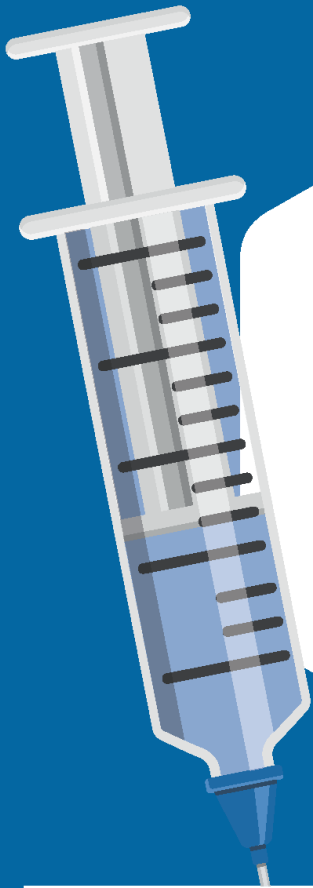
