#### **FALL LEAF AND BRANCH COLLECTION**



The Town of Coalhurst will be offering a leaf, yard waste and branch collection for the fall of 2022 on **October 17th.** 

Leaves and compostable yard waste such as plants and flowers must be **in disposable brown paper bags** available at the Town of Coalhurst office (Maximum 5 per household) or for

purchase at various retailers. *If leaves are in any other type of bag or container, they will not be picked up.* 

Branches must be cut to a maximum length of 6 ft. Please tie smaller branches in manageable bundles with string or twine.


Bags and branches can be placed neatly along the fence in your rear lane. If you do not have a rear lane, they can be placed at the front of your property **no earlier than 1 week before** the collection date. Please do not block rear lanes or sidewalks. The bags and branches must be out **by 7:30 am on October 17th** and there will be **NO CALLBACKS** for pick-up.

#### Did you know? - Q&A about home-based businesses

#### Q: What types of home-based businesses are there?

**A:** There are many kinds of home-based businesses. In Coalhurst there are two (2) categories of home-based businesses:

<u>Home Occupation 1</u> – under this category you do not have an employee and no clients coming to your home. There is no outdoor storage and/or display of goods. All work is done either by phone, computer,

and/or is done off-site away from the home. Some examples of a Home Occupation 1 include caterers, internet-based businesses, plumber, electrician, cleaners, landscapers, and so forth. Home Occupation 1 businesses are a permitted use in all residential districts of Coalhurst.

<u>Home Occupation 2</u> – this is clients coming to your home and you can have up to one non-resident employee. You can also have limited outdoor storage (provided it is screened from view), and you can have sales occurring on the property. Some examples of a Home Occupation 2 include day homes, tax accountants, aesthetics (nails, facials, etc.), music teachers, hair salons, and so forth. Home Occupation 2 businesses are only a permitted in some residential district in Coalhurst.

#### Q: What paperwork do I need from the Town of Coalhurst if I want to run a business from my home?

**A:** To legally operate a home-based business in Coalhurst you need to have a valid Town of Coalhurst Development Permit and Business License. Depending on the type of business you want to operate there may be additional paperwork required (fire inspection, Alberta Health Services inspection, building and safety code permits, etc.) which would be conditions of the Development Permit.

#### Q: How do I get a Development Permit?

A: To obtain a Development Permit for a home-based business you can apply through the Town Office (in-person or by email). Applicants will need to submit a completed application form, provide a brief write-up of the proposed business, and pay the application fee. If the type of business involves clients coming to the property (Home Occupation 2) then additional documentation will be required such as a site plan showing where client parking will be and what part(s) of the property will be used for the business. Application forms and checklists can be obtained at the Town Office or can downloaded from <a href="mailto:coalhurst.ca/services/planning-development/">coalhurst.ca/services/planning-development/</a>. Development Permit applications can be emailed to <a href="mailto:development@coalhurst.ca">development@coalhurst.ca</a> or dropped off at the Town Office.

Once a Development Permit has been issued and any conditions met, then the applicant can obtain their Business License from the Town and begin operating.

#### Q: How much does it cost for these permits & licenses?

**A:** A Development Permit (excluding temporary permits) is valid so long as you live on the property and your business does not change from what was approved. The one-time fee for a Development Permit (excluding temporary permits) is either \$75 (Home Occupation 1) or \$150 (Home Occupation 2). However, if a waiver is needed, for example if a parking waiver is required, there would be an additional fee of \$150.

The Business License for a home-based business is an annual fee of \$25.

#### Q: How long does it take to get the Development Permit?

A: If the application is complete Home Occupation 1 Development Permits usually take 1-3 business days to approve. Home Occupation 2 Development Permit applications usually take 3-4 weeks for a decision as they are reviewed by the Municipal Subdivision and Development Authority (MSDA). If you are applying for a Home Occupation 2 permit then your neighbors will be notified by mail of the application and be provided with an opportunity to provide any comments to the MSDA. The MSDA meets twice a month, every first and third Tuesday, to review applications. The decisions of the MSDA on applications are subject to a 21-day appeal period. Business Licenses for Home Occupation 2 permits can be issued after this appeal period has passed.

#### Q: What are the benefits of getting a Business License?

**A:** If you have a valid business license from the Town of Coalhurst then your business is included in the Town's Business Directory which is mailed out to everyone in Coalhurst every spring. In addition, your business is included on the Town's website and the Town can promote your business to your potential clients who call the Town Office looking for your type of business. You can also have a small sign (maximum 8 sq. ft.) in your window for your home-based business.

The Town of Coalhurst also participates in a reciprocal business licensing agreement with other communities in southern Alberta. If you have a valid Business License from Coalhurst you do not need to obtain another license from these reciprocal communities (\*the reciprocal business licensing agreement is up for renewal and is pending approval).

#### Q: What if I have been operating a home-based business in Coalhurst without approval?

**A:** The Town of Coalhurst is encouraging all businesses to apply for their Development Permit and Business License so the Town can promote these local businesses to as many potential clients as possible. We want to see businesses in Coalhurst be successful and help them by being in a position to promote them.

# PLAN TO GET YOUR FLU SHOT

Getting your flu shot **helps save lives** and **helps our health care system** by reducing the number of people who need medical care.

#### About the flu

- + The flu is very contagious and can spread quickly and easily.
- + Some people with the flu only get mildly ill. Others, like those over 65 years and young children, can get very sick.

#### Who should get the flu shot?

+ Everyone 6 months and older should get the flu shot. It's especially important for people at high risk of health complications from the flu and COVID-19, and for people who can spread the flu to them.

#### The flu shot is safe

- + You can't get the flu from the flu shot.
- + Serious side effects from the flu shot are very rare.

#### The flu shot works

- + You should get the flu shot even if you've already had the COVID-19 vaccine. The COVID-19 vaccine doesn't protect you from the flu.
- + Being protected from both the flu and COVID-19 lowers your risk of severe health complications.
